## How Hi Kent can help

Hi Kent is the registered charity for deaf and hard of hearing people in Kent. Established since 1986, we received the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service in 2007. Our aim is to provide a full range of services that meet the needs of anyone with hearing difficulties, and those who have an interest in their welfare. Our services include:

### Assessment Service

We can assess your needs relating to hearing loss if you are over 65, live in the Kent County Council area and do not use BSL as your first language. This can be in our Resource Centres or your home and equipment may be provided on long term loan funded by Kent County Council.

### Hearing Aid Aftercare Clinics

We run regular Hearing Aid Aftercare clinics in towns, villages, communities and in Gateway Centres throughout Kent for the aftercare of NHS hearing aids. Trained volunteers provide new batteries, retubing and cleaning – all free of charge, and helpful advice is always available.

### Deaf Awareness Courses

Hi Kent can provide specialist Deaf Awareness Courses designed for the individual needs and requirements of any size of company in the private sector, including retail. Public sector courses can also be tailor-made to your requirements.

### Lipreading Classes

We run Lipreading Classes throughout Kent completely free to participants. Lipreading is a tremendously important social skill which enables people who have become deaf to begin to communicate once again and re-establish normal life and social interaction outside their homes and to overcome the

social isolation and despair that deafness can bring. All our classes are extremely successful and are taught by ATLA-qualified tutors.

### Tinnitus Support Groups

Our support groups for people with tinnitus meet regularly in Maidstone, Ashford, and Pembury.

### Commercial Equipment/Services

Hi Kent provides commercial loop systems for business premises, village halls, meeting venues etc.

### Courses and Training

#### British Sign Language

Sign Language is a visual language through which the profoundly deaf can communicate without speech. Hi Kent provides training through courses run by professional tutors, from BSL Levels 1 to 3 inclusive, at very competitive prices.

Our courses are held in convenient venues in towns all over Kent, with daytime and evening options available.

#### Deaf Awareness and Equality Act Training for Frontline Staff

A half day course to train frontline staff to deal effectively with deaf and hard of hearing customers or clients.

#### Training for Care Staff

A one day course providing knowledge and practical skills for care staff dealing with elderly people with hearing loss.
